

Clinical Immunization Requirements

Annually:

- TB skin test (PPD) must show date administered and date read. Result MUST be negative. OR
 - *Accepted – 2 step TB (PPD) skin test, or
 - *Chest x-ray or QuantiFERON Gold Blood Test (Lab report required) annually
 - *Chest X-Ray required in you have ever had a positive TB Skin and/or BCG vaccine
 - *Some facilities may require a negative result every six (6) months or more frequently.
 - *Some facilities will not accept the QuantiFERON.

Seasonally:

- Flu vaccine/Nasal Mist --MUST have documentation each year (August-March, or otherwise determined by the clinical facility)

Every Two Years:

- CPR- BLS for the Healthcare Provider. American Heart Association is accepted ONLY.
 - NO online only CPR courses are accepted.

Every 5 Years:

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) - Must be administered 2019 or later
 - TD is not acceptable.

MMR Series:

- **Positive antibody titer** for all 3 (three): Rubella, Rubeola & Mumps. **Lab report required**
- **If titer is negative – need to restart the series.**
- **Titer is only good 5 years.**

Varicella Series:

- **Positive antibody titer. Lab report required**
- **If titer is negative – need to restart is required.**
- **Titer is only good for 5 years.**

Hepatitis B Series:

- **Positive Antibody Titer is Required:** Completed 1 month after 3rd dose, **Lab report required**
- **If titer is negative, need to restart series.**
- **Titer is only good for 5 years.**

Hepatitis C: Negative Titer, Lab report required

COVID-19 Vaccination: See notice regarding external learning experiences.

Drug Screen: Students must pass a drug screen. Results must be negative.

N95 FIT Testing

- To be completed ONLY if accepted into the program.
- Some facilities require students to be FIT testing for the N95 masks. If you are assigned a clinical site requiring FIT testing, the program will assist with the scheduling of your testing to meet this clinical requirement.

Physical Exam:

- To be completed ONLY if accepted into the program.
- Must be on SJC school form. Can be completed by MD, DO, NP, or PA. The healthcare provider MUST clear you for the program. No exceptions. Valid for 18 months

NOTICE REGARDING EXTERNAL LEARNING EXPERIENCES:

Students enrolling into San Jacinto College programs with external learning experiences (i.e., clinical, practicum, externship, cooperative, etc.) will be required to comply with the immunization requirements and policies of the clinical/external learning sites to engage in all clinical/external learning experiences. Vaccination requirements at clinical/external learning sites are implemented pursuant to the independent authority of such facilities and are not mandated by San Jacinto College. Failure to meet the immunization requirements mandated by clinical/external learning sites may limit a student's ability to complete the program and/or may delay the student's graduation date. San Jacinto College does not process exemptions, and students should address potential vaccination exemptions directly with the clinical/external learning site.
