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If you previously appealed and were approved to receive financial aid but did not meet the conditions of the financial aid appeal committee, you are allowed to submit another appeal. Conditions set by the committee are as follows:

- a) You can only enroll in classes on your declared degree plan.
- b) You cannot take any extra classes that are not on your detailed degree plan.
- c) You cannot change your major without permission from the committee.
- d) You must only earn letter grades of A, B, or C in each enrolled course.
- e) You must follow other condition(s) included in your appeal approval letter.

If you would like to submit another appeal, complete all of the items outlined below.

- Type your response on a separate sheet of paper (include your name, student ID, and signature.) Please include an answer for each question as a separate paragraph and number each paragraph.
- Include documentation that you believe will support your situation.
- Attach a detailed degree evaluation/graduation checklist from the Counseling Center.
- Register for the semester you are appealing.

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**NOTES:**

- Please be prepared to pay for your registration expenses (tuition, fees, books and supplies) since your appeal might not be reviewed prior to the payment deadline.
- You will be notified in writing of the decision. In addition, your SOS account will be updated.
- Your appeal will not be accepted or reviewed until the current term grades have been evaluated.
- Deadlines date to submit your appeal are:  
Summer 2009: Friday, July 10, 2009. Fall 2009: Friday, November 13, 2009.  
Spring 2010: Friday, April 16, 2010. Summer 2010: Friday, July 9, 2010.
