New Repeat Course Fee for Third Repeat

Effective Fall 2007, San Jacinto College will charge a higher tuition rate to Texas resident students registering for a course the third or subsequent time. This charge will apply to any course that the student has already attempted twice and appears on their transcript. Upon the third or subsequent enrollment, an additional tuition of \$50.00 per credit hour will be charged. This additional tuition charge will be assessed for students registered under the Texas resident tuition rates.

Additional Expenses

Students must purchase their own textbooks, workbooks and supplies such as paper and pencils. In addition, some courses in addition, require the purchase of special supplies.

Residence status is determined by the rules and regulations of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. See page 7 in the schedule for required documents.

Students are liable for all collection agency and/or attorney fees and all other costs necessary to collect payment for the debt (see the section titled Delinquent Accounts in the San Jacinto Community College District Catalog).

NOTE: Students are encouraged to complete any class changes before the first day of class. All classes dropped during the scheduled class change period will be assessed 30 percent of the tuition and fees in accordance with published Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Guidelines even if they are replacing the course with another and MAY appear on the transcript as withdrawn.

OTHER FEES

Fees Per Term

1. **GENERAL SERVICE FEE**
A fee of \$130 is charged each Fall, Spring or Summer term. This fee is non-refundable unless the student withdraws from all courses. The refund is pro-rated based on the published refund schedule.
2. **LATE REGISTRATION FEE**
A non-refundable \$25 fee will be charged to any student who enters a new registration after campus registration. This includes a new registration following removal (see page 17) for non-payment.
3. **SCHEDULE CHANGE FEE**
Schedule changes made prior to the first day of class do not incur a fee. Any changes on the first day of class or thereafter are subject to the college refund policy (see page 23-24) of this schedule. Class changes are considered processed at the time of data entry. The student is considered liable for the appropriate charges.
4. **LAB FEES**
See chart on pages 21-22 of this schedule. Lab fees are subject to change.
5. **PARKING PERMIT**
Each student will be entitled to one parking permit by submitting a completed parking application at time of registration. Additional permits may be obtained from the business office for \$1 each. Lost or stolen permits may be replaced at a cost of \$1. A parking permit must be displayed on each automobile parked on a San Jac campus by a student or for the benefit of a student. A fine will be imposed on any student who fails to comply with parking regulations.
6. **LIABILITY INSURANCE**
There is a \$7 charge per class. (Health Sciences clinical courses, Dietetic Technician, Cosmetology, Mental Health Services and Gerontology Services)
7. **DISTANCE LEARNING FEE**

8. **INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROCESSING FEE \$35**
This fee is assessed to students holding F-1 visas each term of enrollment.
9. **FLIGHT:**
Flight courses are subject to regular college tuition and fees. All college tuition and fees must be paid at the time of registration. Flight fee charges are subject to change when the current contract changes.

FLIGHT LOANS for students enrolling in flight courses are available on Central campus. Flight loans for flight fees must be paid in full by the time the student is ready to fly or by the end of the term in which the loan was obtained, whichever comes first. A flight loan covers one-half of the flight fee and may be obtained for only one flight course at a time. A \$25 fee is assessed for each flight loan payable with the first payment of the flight loan.
