Please bring the following on test day:

- Quick THEA Admission ticket
- Two forms of personal identification:
 - One with a recent photograph and your signature (such as a driver's license or passport)
 - Other forms of ID can be a social security card, military ID, student ID, credit card, or employer ID.
 - The fee for the exam is \$29. You may pay by credit card, check or money order made out to Evaluation Systems (check is submitted on exam day). Credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard.
- A jacket or sweater (room temperature may vary).
- Calculator (Examinees will be allowed to use a four-function, non-programmable calculators with square root and percent keys. Examinees who wish to use a calculator for the THEA test will need to bring their own calculator to the test administration.

Parking: There is a parking shortage at certain times of the day. You are advised to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled testing time. **Do Not Park in Staff Parking at anytime.** You will receive a SJCD ticket.

Quick THEA Registration Process

1. Examinee will need to come to the Test Center (Room 133, Administration Building) to register for the Quick THEA exam.
2. Non-SJCD students or examinees, will need to go to Enrollment Services to receive a G00 number in order to register.
3. There is a \$10 (non-refundable) service fee that must be paid prior to taking the exam. Examinee will need to complete the registration form on the registration day, which may take about 30 minutes.
4. Examinee will need to pay the \$29 exam fee on the day of the exam via credit card, check or money order made out to Evaluation Systems (check is submitted on exam day). Credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard.
5. Examinee will need to report to the Test Center no later than 8 a.m. on the exam day. Late examinees will not be permitted to test.
6. There will be a \$10 (non-refundable) service fee for all examinees that re-schedule their Quick THEA test date.
7. Official scores will be mailed directly from Evaluation Systems to the address indicated on the registration form in about seven to ten working days from the test date.

Prohibited Calculators

1. You may not bring with you or use during the test administration any of the following types of calculators:
 - Scientific or graphing calculators
 - Pocket organizers
 - Hand-held, laptop, or notebook computers
 - Electronic writing pads or pen-input devices
 - Calculators with an alphanumeric keyboard
 - Calculators with paper tape
 - Calculators that make noise or “talk”
 - Calculators with electrical cords
 - Business or financial planning calculators
 - Calculator watches
 - Calculators with rulers
2. You will not be allowed to share a calculator with another examinee.
3. If you use a calculator with a large or raised display that might be visible to other examinees, you may be seated at the discretion of the proctor.
4. Testing staff will not have calculators or batteries available.

Quick THEA Test Results

1. You can visit Counseling in about seven to ten working days from the date of the test to retrieve your test scores.
2. You will also receive a copy of your test results by mail from Evaluation Systems to the address that you indicated on your registration form in about seven to ten working days from the test date.

Quick THEA Re-test Policy

Examinees must wait 30 days from last test date in order to be eligible to retake the Quick THEA exam.
