



Financial Aid Bookstore Charges Information

Fall 2008 and Spring 2009

- Any remaining funds from Pell Grant and other Financial Aid Grants may be used to charge books and supplies at the San Jacinto College Bookstore (Barnes and Noble).
- Your Schedule Bill and a photo ID are needed to charge your books and supplies. You may obtain a copy of the Schedule Bill from either a campus business office or the SOS website (www.sos.sjcd.edu).
- Your financial aid funds CAN be used at any SJC campus bookstore.
- Fall 2008 charges begin Monday, August 4, 2008 and end on Tuesday, September 9, 2008, if your classes are 16 weeks in length. If your class begins after August 25, see the next item.
- If you are taking a class that begins during the term, you may charge your books and supplies at the bookstore up to the first class day of that part of term. Example, if your class begins October 20 you may charge in the bookstore until the first day of your class.
- Spring 2009 charges begin Monday, December 8, 2008 and end on Tuesday, February 3, 2009, if your classes are 16 weeks in length.
- Winter Mini is part of the Spring Term. Therefore, your spring funds may be used to charge books and supplies.
- If your book(s) are not on the shelf at the time of charges, you may prepay for the books with your financial aid grant(s). Once the book(s) arrive, you will be notified to pick them up at the SJC bookstore.
- If you are on Financial Aid Suspension, your funds are not available to charge your books and supplies.
- If you are on Financial Aid Probation or a Financial Aid Appeal Approval, your funds will not be available until after grades from the previous term are received and reviewed.
- If you have any remaining funds after tuition, fees, books, and supplies are paid, your remaining funds will be disbursed to you. See SJC website for additional information.
